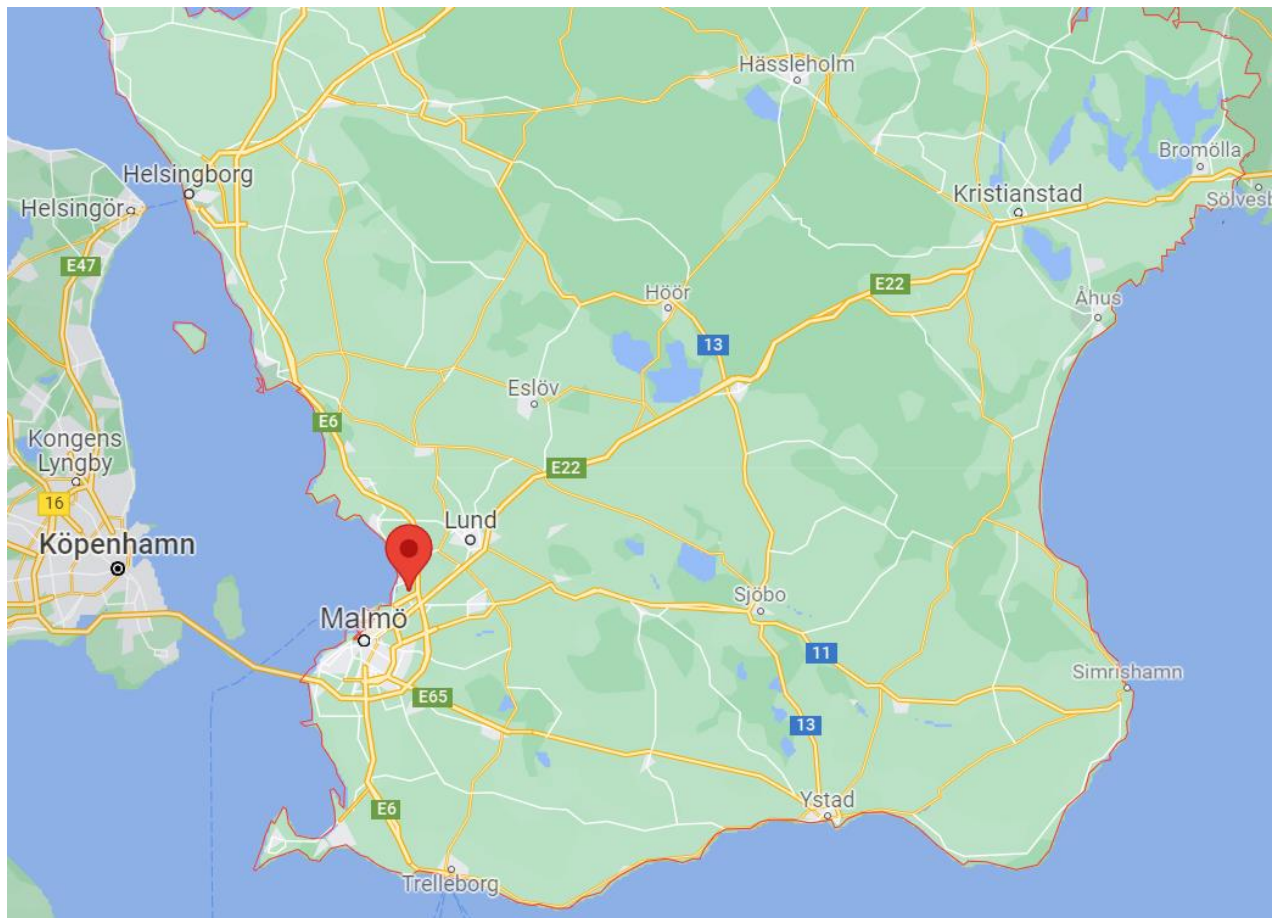


Accommodation at SLU in Alnarp



SLU Accommodation

Alnarp student housing offers approximately 240 types of accommodation, most of which is in Alnarp. Accommodation includes shared student housing, the Greenhouse hall of residence in Malmö, flats in Lomma and a small housing unit on the outskirts of Lomma. Alnarp is part of Lomma Municipality and there are direct bus connections to Lomma, Lund and Malmö. Lomma, Åkarp and Arlöv are all within cycling distance of Alnarp. Trains run from Lomma to most of south-west Skåne. We mainly offer shared student housing, where students have a private room and share a kitchen and bathrooms with other residents. The size, standard, and price of these rooms vary. Some accommodation has been reserved by various departments, meaning that certain student groups, visiting research fellows and others are given priority.



Campus Alnarp and the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences (SLU) are close to the coast of south-west Skåne between Malmö and Lund.

Housing waiting list

Students who aren't guaranteed accommodation will need to sign up for the SLU housing waiting list if they want to live on the Alnarp campus. The list starts over each academic year, starting on 1st August and running to 31st July the following year. You will need to re-register every year to keep your place on the list. This only applies if you have not been allocated housing from SLU student accommodation.

If you register on 1 August or later, you will join the waiting list for the academic year starting at the end of August/start of September. When you register you will not receive an automatic confirmation email. However, the website will display:

“Thank you for your registration. If you have any questions, contact housing@slu.se.”

How accommodation is allocated

The sooner you join the waiting list, the greater chance you have of being allocated accommodation. Make sure to register as early as possible on 1st August.

It is difficult to say exactly when you will find out if you have been allocated accommodation on campus. This will be influenced by several factors, many of which are beyond our control. Make sure you provide the correct email and telephone number in your application as we will use these to contact you to offer you accommodation. As previously mentioned, the time this will take depends on several factors. However, if you have not been contacted by the end of August, it is unlikely you will be offered a room. Rooms might become available at the start of the semester if other students drop out, for example. This can free up student rooms at the start of September, so it might be worth contacting us then again.



General information

Unlike many other housing companies, Alnarp student housing has a two-month notice period. Please respect this when you decide to terminate your accommodation contract. You must terminate your contract in writing, either via email or letter.

The same things apply for the majority of our accommodation, however there are some exceptions. Usually, residents only pay rent for nine months of the year. However, some accommodation charges rent for 12 months. Those who pay rent for nine months will not have to pay anything over the summer if they continue studying at SLU and live in the same accommodation for the following autumn semester.

All student accommodation is only intended for students, unless otherwise stated.

Sometimes, students only need accommodation for a short period and this can often be arranged. We charge partial and full rent per calendar month, with certain adjustments. For example, if you move in on 1st February and move out on 13th February, you will pay half of the month's rent.

Usually included in our accommodation:

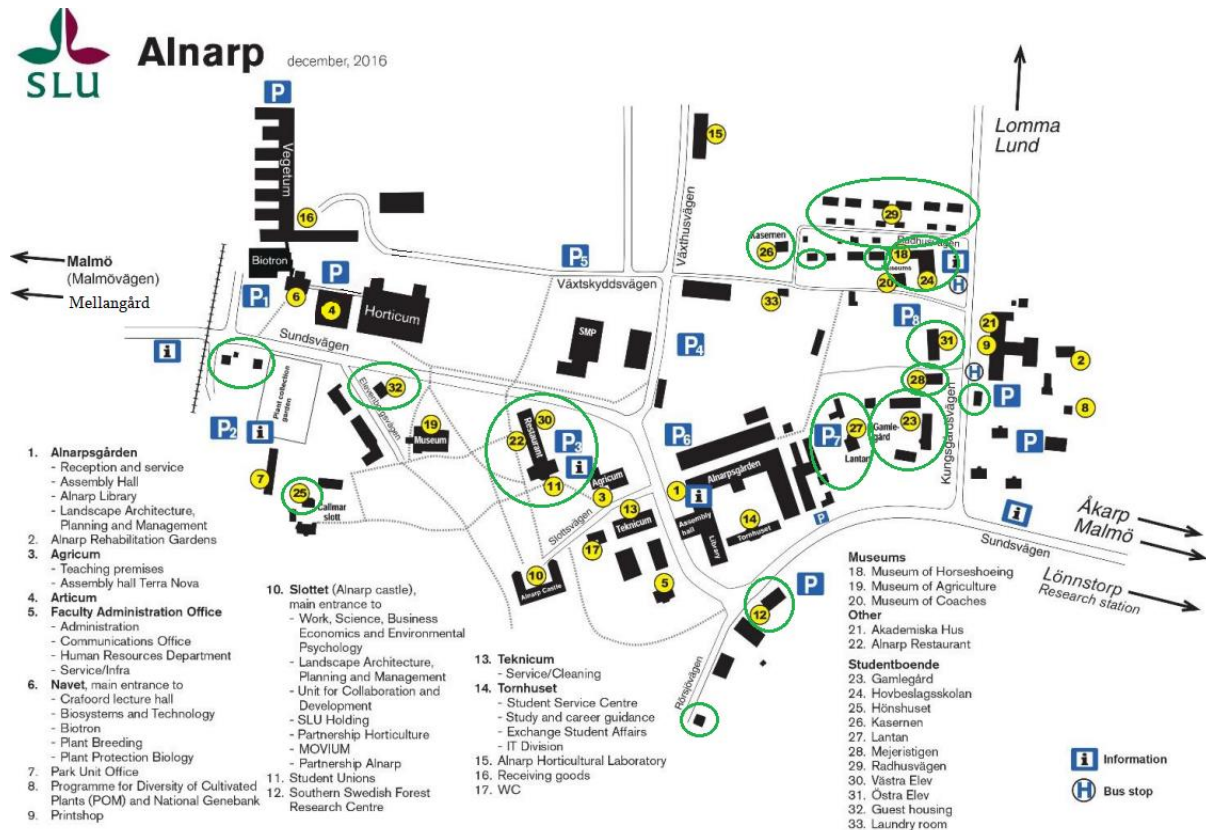
Heating, water, electricity, waste collection, furniture in the room being rented (bed, duvet, pillow, desk, chair, wardrobe, book case, fire alarm) and in communal areas. Kitchen utensils and vacuum cleaners are also included. Each description of the houses below contains information about whether the accommodation is furnished or unfurnished. You can bring your own smaller items of furniture, such as bedside tables, however please note that you may not get rid of the existing furniture in the room. The room is rented with the existing furniture. Cleaning services will clean communal areas (floors) and bathrooms once per week in housing with more than eight residents. This service is not comprehensive, as a resident you are responsible for keeping your accommodation clean and tidy. Rent also includes access to laundry facilities.

Not usually included in our accommodation:

TV, telephone line, internet/Wi-Fi (connection is available but you will need to arrange your own subscription with a provider) and insurance. Bed sheets, washing powder, washing up liquid, dishcloths, etc. are also not included.

Our accommodation

Below you will find details about all of the accommodation we offer. Rent varies considerably depending on the type of accommodation, from large shared accommodation and smaller house shares to large and small flats. The map below shows some of the accommodation available on campus. This is marked in green.



Lantbruksskolan “Lantan” – Hall of residence

Address: Gamlegård 6, Alnarp Campus

Number of rooms: 20, divided over two corridors

Furnished: Yes

Area: 17–20m²

Rent: SEK 3,758–4,279 SEK, 9 months (2022)

Historical student accommodation which has hosted students for generations. Lantbruksskolan is a large hall of residence with 20 rooms over two floors. Communal toilets, showers and kitchen on each floor. Newly refurbished laundry facilities in the basement. Rooms are approximately 20m² some of the largest student rooms on campus.



Hovbeslagarskolan “Horse House” – shared housing

Address: Smedjevägen 2A, Alnarp Campus (right next to the Alnarp bus stop)

Number of rooms: 10, divided over three floors

Furnished: Yes

Area: 12–17m²

Rent: 3,787–4,281 SEK, 9 months (2022)

Medium-sized student housing on Campus Alnarp, located close to the bus stop on Kungsgårdsvägen. Hovbeslagarskolan has ten rooms divided over three floors. Each floor has a bathroom. Communal kitchen and dining area on the ground floor. Laundry facilities are a few minutes' walk from the building.



Västra elev – shared housing

Address: Sundsvägen 9, Alnarp Campus (above the Alnarp restaurant)

Refurbished: 2021

Number of rooms: 9

Furnished: Yes

Area: 17–18m²

Rent: SEK 3,978–4,080 SEK, 9 months (2022)

Västra elev is located in the same building as the Alnarp restaurant in the centre of the campus. It houses nine students and includes a kitchen, two toilets, two showers and a number of washbasins. There is also a small living room. All residents have their own rooms and laundry facilities are next to the toilet and shower areas.



Lusthyllan – shared housing

Address: Sundsvägen 9B, Alnarp Campus (above the students' union)

Refurbished: 2021

Number of rooms: 13

Furnished: Yes

Area: 8–22m²

Rent: SEK 2,856–4,284 SEK, 9 months (2022)

Lusthyllan has 13 rooms. Residents have access to a large kitchen and a number of toilets. It is located above the students' union and is reserved accommodation. It is intended for students at the Agriculture and Rural Management programme. Room size varies considerably.



Östra elev “Ostra” – hall of residence

Address: Kungsgårdsvägen 3, Alnarp Campus

Is being refurbished: 2022-2023

Number of rooms: 23, divided over two floors

Furnished: Yes

Area: 8–17m²

Rent: SEK 3,000–3,800 SEK, 9 months (2022)

Östra elev is one of the larger halls of residence in Alnarp and houses a total of 23 students. Each floor has a kitchen, several toilets and showers. There is a large common room on the upper floor where students gather to eat and socialise.



House 15, “IKEA house” – hall of residence

Address: Sundsvägen 1, Alnarp Campus

Refurbished: 2016

Number of rooms: 24, divided over three floors

Furnished: Yes

Area: 9–17m²

Rent: SEK 3,519–4,391 SEK, 12 months (2022)

House 15 is located on campus and was refurbished in 2016. It is spread over three floors, and the first two are reserved for students studying courses given by the *Southern Swedish Forest Research Centre*. Visiting research fellows to the Department of Plant Breeding live on the third floor, wifi internet is included on this floor. Laundry facilities for residents are located in the building's basement. Both the communal and private rooms are furnished.



House 18 – shared housing for visiting research fellows

Address: Rörsjövägen 3, Alnarp Campus

Refurbished: 2016

Number of rooms: 6 over two floors

Furnished: Yes

Area: 9–15m²

Rent: SEK 4,051–4,118 SEK, 12 months (2022)

This shared housing is reserved almost entirely for visiting research fellows to the Department of Plant Breeding. There are six rooms, three toilets, and two showers. Laundry facilities are available in the basement and there is a living room adjacent to the kitchen. Common areas and all rooms are fully furnished. Wifi internet is included in the rent.



Västra lärarbostaden – shared student housing

Address: Sundsvägen 13, Alnarp Campus

Refurbished: 2021

Number of rooms: 4 over two floors

Furnished: No

Area: 13–17m²

Rent: SEK 4,182–4,386 SEK, 9 months (2022)

Västra lärarbostaden accommodates four people. For a long time, this accommodation was designated for SLU staff. However, the building has since been refurbished to house students. Each student has their own room and shares the two bathrooms and kitchen with the other residents. The common areas are furnished, however the student rooms are not. Laundry facilities are available in the building's basement.



Östra lärarbostaden – shared student housing

Address: Sundsvägen 11, Alnarp Campus

Refurbished: 2021

Number of rooms: 5, over two floors

Furnished: No

Area: 11–20m²

Rent: SEK 3,672–4,590 SEK, 9 months (2022)

Östra lärarbostaden houses five students. For a long time, this accommodation was designated for SLU staff. However, the building has since been refurbished to house students. The common areas are furnished, however the individual rooms are not. Two students live on the ground floor, three live on the upper floor. They share a kitchen, two toilets and a shower. A washing machine and tumble dryer are available in the basement.



Mellangård – student flats

Address: Malmövägen 3A and 3B

Furnished: No

Area: 33–49m²

Rent: SEK 4,500–6,142 SEK, 12 months (2022)

Mellangård has five flats varying in size from 33m² to 49m². These are highly sought-after and generally you will need to have lived on campus for a while to be able to be allocated one of these flats. All flats are unfurnished. They have their own bathroom with toilet and shower and a kitchen. The flats share laundry facilities which are located close to the building, the same applies to a small storage space. Heating, water, electricity and internet is included in the rent.



Radhusvägen 1A, 3B, 7B, 9A, 11B – shared student housing

Address: Radhusvägen 1A, 3B, 7B, 9A, 11B, Alnarp Campus

Refurbished: 2022

Number of rooms: 2

Furnished: Yes

Area: 11–14m²

Rent: SEK 4,500 SEK, 9 months (2022)

There are a number of small housing blocks along Radhusvägen. These are home to two students, each with their own room. Students share a kitchen, bathroom and living room. On-site laundry facilities are available.



Radhusvägen 2B, Alnarp – shared student housing

Address: Radhusvägen 2B, Alnarp Campus

Refurbished: 2022 (no pictures available)

Number of rooms: 3, over two floors

Furnished: Yes

Area: 10–18m²

Rent: SEK 3,800–4,100 SEK, 9 months (2022)

This small house accommodates three students, each with their own room. Students share a kitchen and bathroom. Two of the rooms are on the ground floor and one on the upper floor. On-site laundry facilities are available.

Radhusvägen 3A, 7A, 11A, Alnarp – shared student housing

Address: Radhusvägen 3A, 7A, 11A, Alnarp Campus

Refurbished: 2022

Number of rooms: 4, over two floors

Furnished: Yes

Area: 11–14m²

Rent: SEK 3,900–4,200 SEK, 9 months (2022)

There are two student rooms on the ground floor and two on the upper floor. The kitchen and bathroom are located on the ground floor and there is a small living room on the top floor. On-site laundry facilities are available.



Radhusvägen 5A – studio flat

Address: Radhusvägen 5A, Alnarp Campus

Refurbished: 2020

Furnished: Yes

Area: 25m²

Rent: SEK 4,590 SEK, 12 months (2022)

The only student flat on campus. It has its own kitchen with a kitchen island and an own bathroom. On-site laundry facilities are a short walk away. The flat is furnished similar to our student rooms.

Radhusvägen 8 – shared student housing

Address: Radhusvägen 8, Alnarp Campus

Refurbished: 2021

Number of rooms: 6, over two floors

Furnished: Yes

Area: 11–14m²

Rent: 3060 – 3672 SEK, 9 months (2022)

Shared student housing with six student rooms over two floors. Four rooms on the ground floor, two in the basement. Students share three toilets and two showers, a kitchen and a common room in the basement. There is a washing machine and tumble dryer in the basement. The common areas and student rooms are furnished.



Pet-friendly Kasernen, Radhusvägen 13, Alnarp

Address: Radhusvägen 13, Alnarp Campus

Refurbished: 2022 (no pictures available)

Number of rooms: 8, over three corridors

Furnished: Yes

Area: 12–14m²

Rent: SEK 4,000–4,200 SEK, 9 months (2022)

Kasernen is one of few houses where you are allowed to stay with a pet on campus. The ground floor has two separate student corridors for two persons with a communal kitchenette and bathroom. The upper floor has four student rooms with a shared kitchenette and two bathrooms. All student rooms and common areas are furnished. On-site laundry facilities are available.



House 93, “Mejeristigen” – shared student housing

Address: Mejeristigen 1, Alnarp Campus

Refurbished: 2021

Number of rooms: 3

Furnished: Yes

Area: 11–18m²

Rent: SEK 3,774–4,386 SEK, 9 months (2022)

House 93 is one flat with three rooms. There is a shared bathroom and kitchen. Laundry and storage facilities can be found in the building. Two rooms are 18m² and one is 11m². There are a few stairs leading up to the flat. The other flats in the building are rented by people who are not students at SLU. The entire flat is fully furnished.



Gästforskarboendet, House 102, “Researcher house”

Address: Elevenborgsvägen 1, Alnarp Campus

Refurbished: 2021

Number of rooms: 9, over two floors

Furnished: Yes

Area: 12–14m²

Rent: SEK 3672–4,539 SEK, 12 months (2022)

This accommodation houses visiting research fellows, doctoral students, and external consultants. The building has nine separate rooms and residents share two kitchens, four toilets and three showers. There is a communal living room on the upper floor. Laundry facilities are available in the building’s basement. Common areas and all the rooms are fully furnished. Wifi internet is included in the rent.



Gamlegård 3A and 3B– shared student housing

Address: Gamlegård 3A and 3B, Alnarp Campus

Refurbished: 2021

Number of rooms: 5 per building

Furnished: Yes

Area: 12–22m²

Rent: SEK 3,468–3,774 SEK, 9 months (2022)

Gamlegård 3A and 3B is located in the same building. But the house is divided into two corridors where five people each are staying. Both corridors have a kitchen as well as two bathrooms. Laundry facilities are available in the neighbouring Lantbruksskolan building. All student rooms and common areas are furnished.



Gamlegård 4A – shared student housing

Address: Gamlegård 4A, Alnarp Campus

Refurbished: 2021

Number of rooms: 4

Furnished: Yes

Area: 14–19m²

Rent: SEK 4,080–4,386 SEK, 9 months (2022)

Students share an open plan kitchen and living space. Unlike most other Campus Alnarp accommodation, each room has its own bathroom. Laundry facilities are available in the neighbouring Lantbruksskolan building. All student rooms and common areas are furnished.



Gamlegård 4B – shared student housing

Address: Gamlegård 4B, Alnarp Campus

Refurbished: 2016

Number of rooms: 10

Furnished: Yes

Area: 9–15m²

Rent: SEK 3,468–3,672 SEK, 9 months (2022)

Residents share three bathrooms, a kitchen and a living room. They each have their own bedroom. Bedrooms and common areas are all furnished. Laundry facilities are available in the building.



Gamlegård 5A – shared student housing

Address: Gamlegård 5A, Alnarp Campus

Number of rooms: 3

Furnished: Yes

Area: 13–18m²

Rent: SEK 3,570–3,876 SEK, 9 months (2022)

Shared student housing with private rooms and a communal kitchen and bathroom. All student rooms and common areas are furnished. Laundry facilities are available in the neighbouring Lantbruksskolan building.



Gamlegård 5B, shared student housing

Address: Gamlegård 5B, Alnarp Campus

Refurbished: 2021

Number of rooms: 6 over two floors

Furnished: Yes

Area: 10–12m²

Rent: SEK 3,468 SEK, 9 months (2022)

Each floor has a bathroom and a kitchen. There are two rooms on the ground floor and four rooms on the upper floor. Rooms are between 10–12m². Laundry facilities are available in the neighbouring Lantbruksskolan building.



Ebbas – shared student housing

Address: Kungsgårdsvägen 6, Alnarp Campus

Refurbished: 2021

Number of rooms: 5

Furnished: Yes

Area: 10–14m²

Rent: SEK 3,672–4,080 SEK, 9 months (2022)

This accommodation was previously rented out to SLU staff. It has recently been turned into shared housing for five students. It has a communal kitchen, toilet, and shower. All rooms are furnished and a washing machine and tumble dryer can be found in the basement. There is also a space that can be used as a living room. The toilet, kitchen, and all student rooms are on the ground floor.



Hönshuset “Hen House” – shared student housing

Address: Plantvägen 4C, Alnarp Campus

Number of rooms: 4

Furnished: Yes

Area: 12–14m²

Rent: SEK 2,917 SEK, 9 months (2022)

Accommodation for four students. Shared toilet, shower, and kitchen. The building is located in the centre of the Alnarp Park. The accommodation is on the first floor. All student rooms and common areas are furnished. Laundry facilities are available in the shared campus laundrette.



Lönnstorp – shared student housing

Address: Bomhögsvägen 4B, Lomma

Number of rooms: 3 single, 1 double

Furnished: No

Area: 13–27m²

Rent: SEK 4,291–5,689 SEK, 9 months (2022)

This student accommodation is located on the outskirts of Lomma. Campus is either a five minute drive or ten minute bike ride away. It accommodates four-five students. Students have their own unfurnished rooms and share a bathroom and kitchen. There is a small lean-to room. There is a washing machine and tumble dryer in one of the bathrooms. The hall is reserved by the Union for Students of Agricultural and Rural Management and is intended for students on the Agriculture and Rural Management programme.



Korngatan flats

Address: Korngatan 7A/B and 9A/B, Lomma

Furnished: No

Area: 75–88m²

Rent: SEK 9,456–11,805 SEK, 12 months (2022)

We have four flats located on Korngatan in Lomma. These are highly sought after two and three-bedroom flats. There is a washing machine and tumble dryer in the flat's bathroom. Kitchens are equipped with dishwashers. These flats are unfurnished and usually rented by visiting research fellows and their families. Each flat has an adjacent storage room. The ground floor flats have a small garden which residents must maintain. However, student housing provides gardening tools such as a lawnmower and hedge trimmer.



Greenhouse – two halls of residence

Address: Augustenborgsgatan 5B, Malmö

Number of rooms: 12, 6 per corridor. Each corridor has its own entrance.

Furnished: No

Area: 10–24.5m²

Rent: SEK 4,400–7,140 SEK, 12 months (2022)

Two student corridors on the same floor of the Greenhouse hall of residence in Malmö. Each corridor houses six–seven SLU students. Each corridor has five single-occupancy rooms and one double room. Residents have their own rooms and share a spacious kitchen, toilets and showers. Greenhouse has been built with sustainable living in mind. Each corridor has a balcony and a glazed balcony as well as an indoor greenhouse. Double rooms cost more than single rooms. Rent includes internet, heating, water, and electricity.
