

IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO ALL HOUSEHOLDS/ PLACES OF WORK

Bike race

On **13–14 May 2017**, the 109th Scandinavian Race will take place in Uppsala. During these two days, **no traffic of any kind will be allowed along the race route. The only exception is transport to or from your home or place of work. Those covered by this exception will be assisted by security guards, police and race stewards on motorcycles.** This may involve a detour, as **it is absolutely forbidden to drive in the opposite direction of the race participants.**

Start and finish: Dag Hammarskjölds väg (outside the Botanic Garden)

We ask you to please assist the race organisers by not using the roads that make up the race route unnecessarily during the times given below:

SATURDAY: 11AM-5.30PM

Dag Hammarskjölds väg – Thunbergsvägen – Villavägen – Södra Rudbecksgatan – Kåbovägen – BMC – Regementsvägen – Ulleråker – Dag Hammarskjölds väg – Ultuna – Ulleråker – Eklundshovsvägen – Glunten – Dag Hammarskjölds väg

SUNDAY: 11AM–5PM

Dag Hammarskjölds väg – Övre Slottsgatan – Åsgränd – Riddartorget – Trädgårdsgatan – Carolinabacken – Slottsbacken – Borggården – Kung Jans väg – Dag Hammarskjölds väg – Finish

Both days, it is absolutely forbidden to stop at any place along the race route. The section of Dag Hammarskjölds väg between Artillerigatan and Thunbergsvägen will be closed off between 6.30am and 5.30pm on Saturday and between 7am and 5pm on Sunday.

In connection with the race, there will be a bike route for children (Pelle Svanslös-loppet) in and around the Botanic Garden. There will also be a route for MTB bikes starting in Dag Hammarskjölds väg along Uppsalaåsen to Sunnerstagropen – Henry Sälde's väg – Gustaf Kjellbergs väg – Emmy Rappes väg – Sunnerstavägen – Kronåsvägen.
