

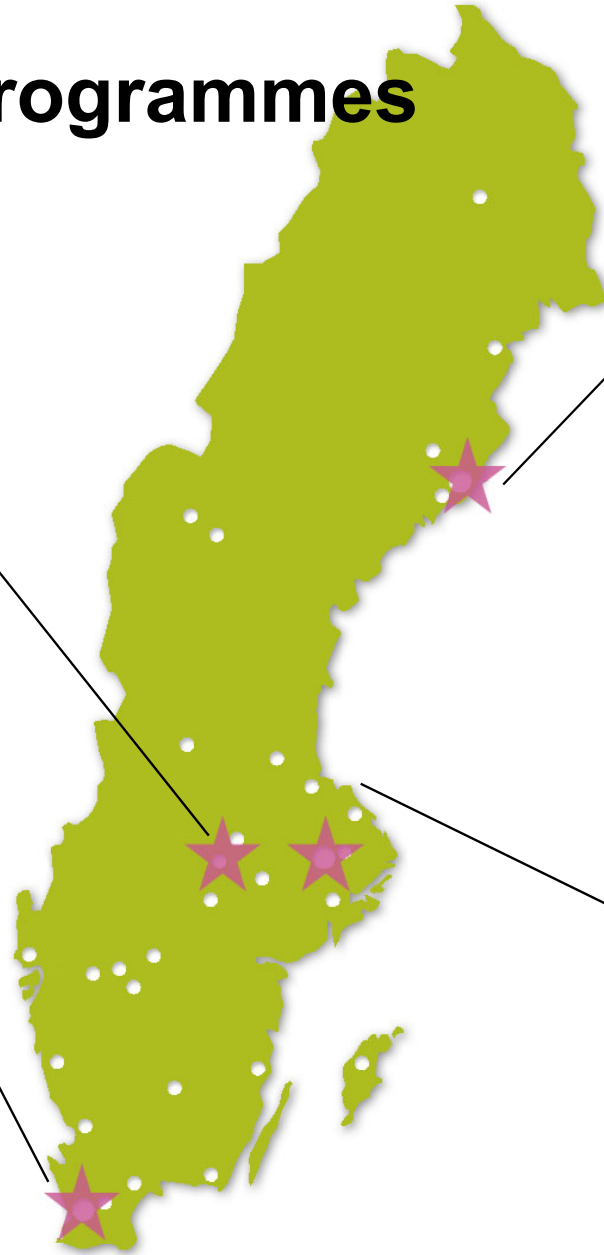

  - main-streamers as well as unique profiles!
- Open mind regarding (starting point for) work's location helps!
- MSc gives other competences, and it is more likely to lead to management/specialist jobs.
- Might be good with work experience between BSc and MSc, but the likelihood to "come back" for a MSc is rather small if starting to work.
