

- ✓ At the first class, you will receive info about course requirements regarding exams and grading.
- ✓ Read the course syllabus to find out more about the requirements to pass the course and the grading scale.

SLU access card and the Mecenat card

SLU Access Card

- ✓ You will receive an email to pick up your access card from the service center
 automatically after you have registered.
- ✓ Printing, copying, opening doors on campus

Mecenat card

- ✓ Digital student card the only one valid in Sweden as a student ID http://mecenat.com
- ✓ Contact the student union about becoming a member and how to get your card

**Remember: you are not eligible for student discounts on the buses/trains until you have a Mecenat card. If you do not have one and you purchase the discounted tickets, you could be subject to a fine if you get caught by the ticket control
