



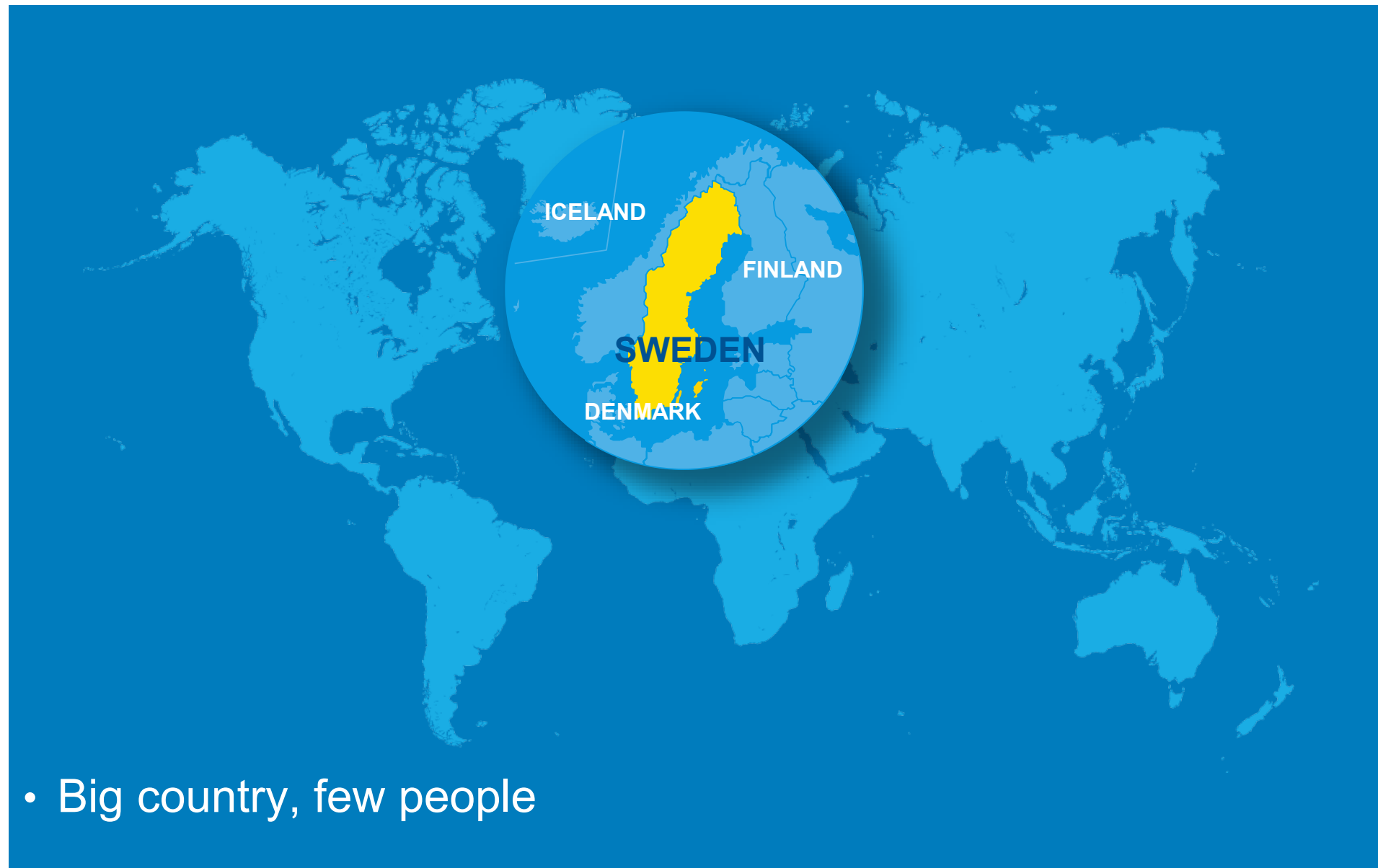

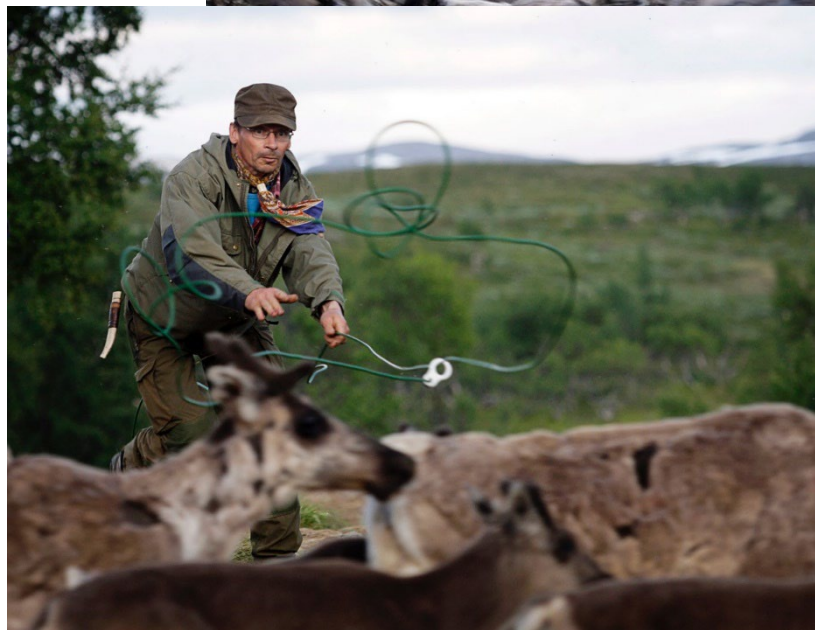

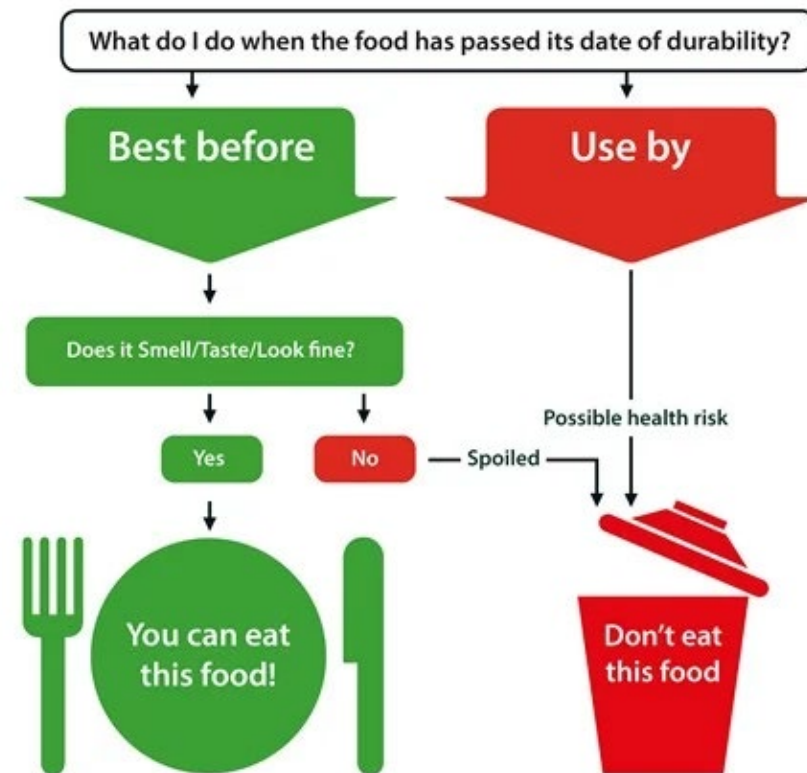

- Blocket.se or Facebook buy/sell

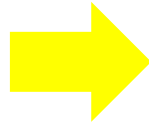
What do Swedes do?

- Winter swimming



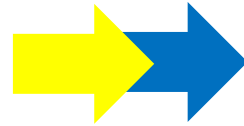
