Transportation and the cashless society of Sweden

Mobility team

Banks, post offices & mobile phones

- Sweden is largely cashless
 - Use mainly debit and credit cards
 - No ATMs on campus
- Swish app for direct payments (requires a personal Swedish identity number)
 - Alternatives like Apple Pay/Google Pay/Paypal..
- Postnord counters at many local shops/supermarkets
 - Packages will be delivered to the closest counter to you



Freja+

For those of you who don't have a Swedish personal identity number, you need to fulfil the following criteria:

- ✓ Have a biometric passport and are a citizen from an EU/EEA country
- ✓ Have a confirmed level of identity with the Swedish Tax Agency
- ✓ Have an address registered in SPAR that we can mail to

Transportation

- Cash is not accepted on buses/trains
- Credit/debit cards can often be used on local buses, also available on apps
- On trains you need to buy the ticket in the app of the company or ticket vending machines in advance before entering the train

Transportation - student discount

- Important that you have *the Mecenat card* before buying a ticket with student discount
 - If you join the student union you will get instructions for the digital card.
 - If you want a physical card, you can request one once you receive your digital card.
- Must present *valid ID and student card* if train/bus attendant check your ticket:
 - The Mecenat card with SJ logo/travel symbol
 - The Studentkortet with SJ logo/travel symbol
 - WeStudents with travel symbol
 - The ISIC card
- Risk of high fines if you do not have a valid ID and can prove that you are a student


Campus Uppsala (Ultuna)

To Uppsala city from Arlanda Airport (terminal 4 or 5):

- Regional bus 801  Leave from SkyCity. 100 SEK. Tickets can be bought at:
 - Arlanda visitor centre at terminal 5
 - Information desks in terminal 4
 - On board with card
 - On the UL app
- Train. 200 SEK. Tickets can be bought from
 - SJ:s website or app
 - At the tourist information desk or train ticket office
- Taxi - more expensive. Company from Uppsala.

Campus Uppsala (Ultuna)

From the city to Campus

- Local transportation app: UL (student discount) 
- From Uppsala city to campus
 - Yellow bus nr 100 or 101.
 - Green bus nr 4 - more departures but takes longer time.
 - From Flogsta – bus nr 12.
- Plenty of students buy a second-hand bike for travel
 - Second hand: Facebook marketplace, Facebook groups, Blocket..
 - Flyers in town at the beginning of the semester where you can find second hand bikes



Campus Alnarp

Arrival to

- Kastrup, Copenhagen Airport (Denmark), or
- Sturup, Malmö Airport
- Paper tickets through ticket machines at train stations and airport.

Local transportation app: Skånetrafiken (student discount both in Skåne and to Copenhagen)



Campus Umeå

Arrival to Umeå Airport

- Airport bus (nr 80) to Umeå City (Vasaplan)
- Pay with card on bus, vending machine at the airline bus stop or through app Ultra



Campus Alnarp

From city to campus

- From Malmö: Train to Burlöv station or Lomma station and change to yellow bus nr 139 and get off at Campus Alnarp
- From Lund: Bus nr 139 directly from Lund central station or train to Burlöv station and then bus nr 139



Campus Umeå

From city to campus:

- Local bus from Umeå Vasaplan or Umeå Östra to bus stop Umeå Universum.
- Plenty of students buy a second-hand bike for travel
