Free of charge

Personal injury insurance for university students in Sweden

- Students and doctoral students
- Cover costs you may accrue due to an **accident**
- Valid during school hours, all the time you spend on SLU's premises
- During direct journey between home and the place where the school hours are spent.



European Health Insurance Card



- If you are an EU/EEA or Swiss citizen, you need to bring the European Health Insurance Card from your home country.
- Obtain the card in your home country before coming to Sweden.
- With the card you are entitled to the same benefits, and pay the same fees, as a Swedish citizen when visiting health care center or hospital.



Supplementary insurance policies for foreign students



FASplus

- Insurance for students who pay tuition fees
- SLU scholarship holders and SI scholarship holders
- Valid around the clock in Sweden for the duration of your studies
- Also valid during holidays if you continue to study after the holiday
- **Urgent** medical and dental care, third party liability, legal expenses





Insurance for foreign visitors

SLU has signed this insurance for:

Foreign students with citizenship of an EU/EEA country or Switzerland (except exchange students who are covered by another insurance policy).

- Valid around the clock
- **Urgent** medical and dental care, third party liability, legal expenses





Travelling abroad as part of education


If you travel abroad as an exchange student or as a part of a course or independent project, SLU will arrange the Student OUT insurance for you.



How to make an injury report

- Chose the right claim form
- Claim for all your costs. Kammarkollegiet will decide how much to refund.
- You have to print the form and sign it.
- SLU also have to sign the form. Study counsellor or teacher or administrative staff can help.
