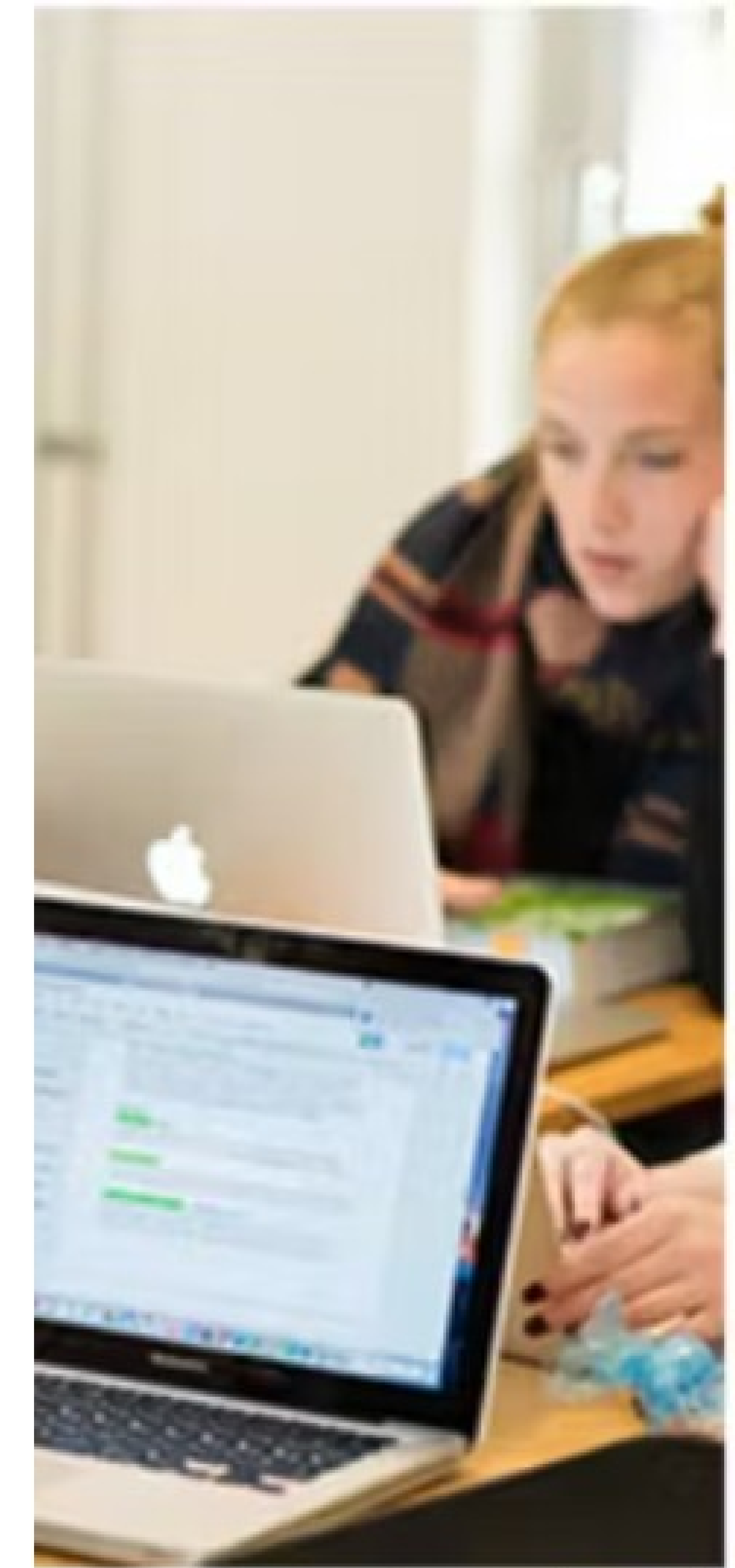

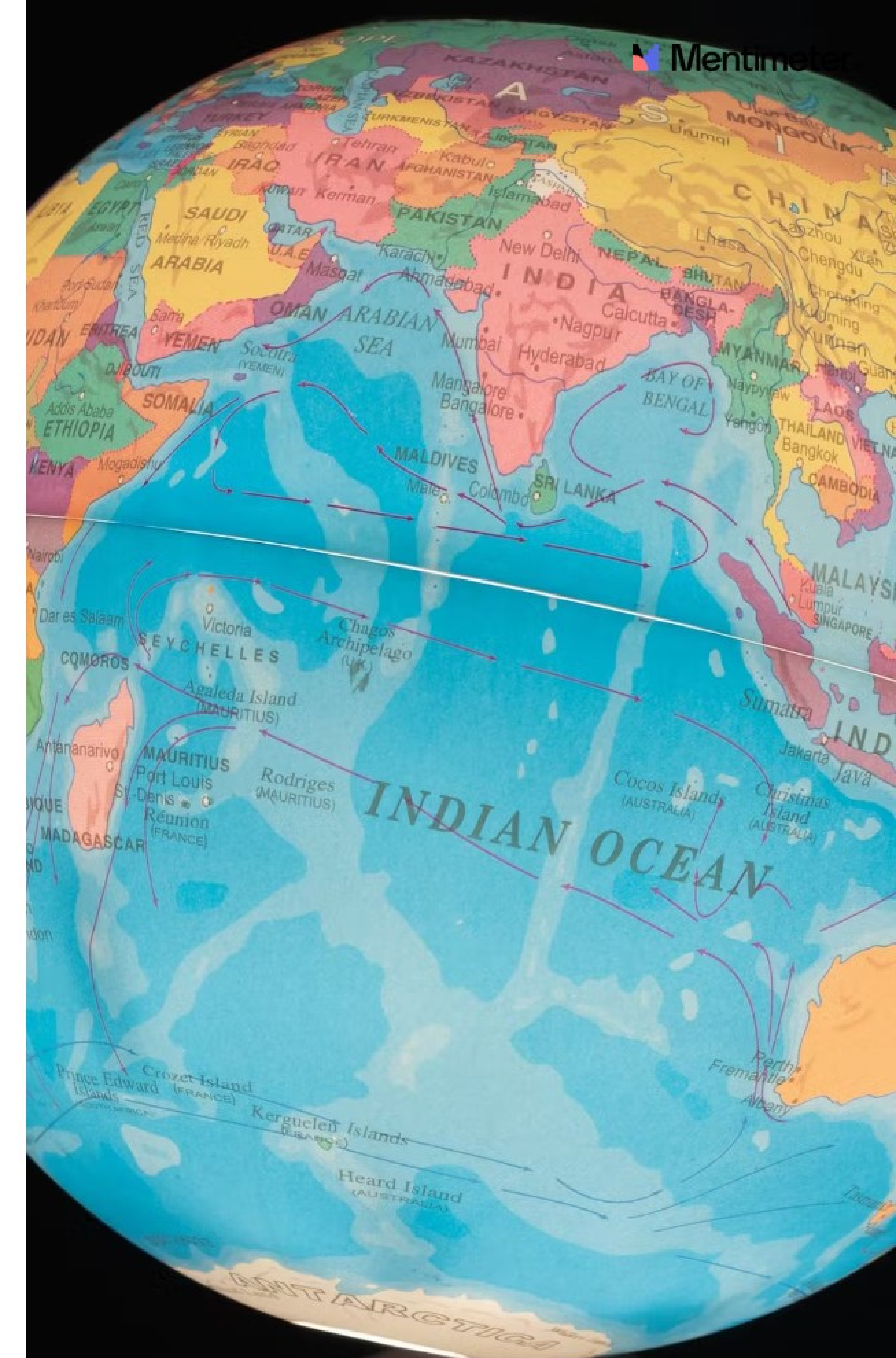

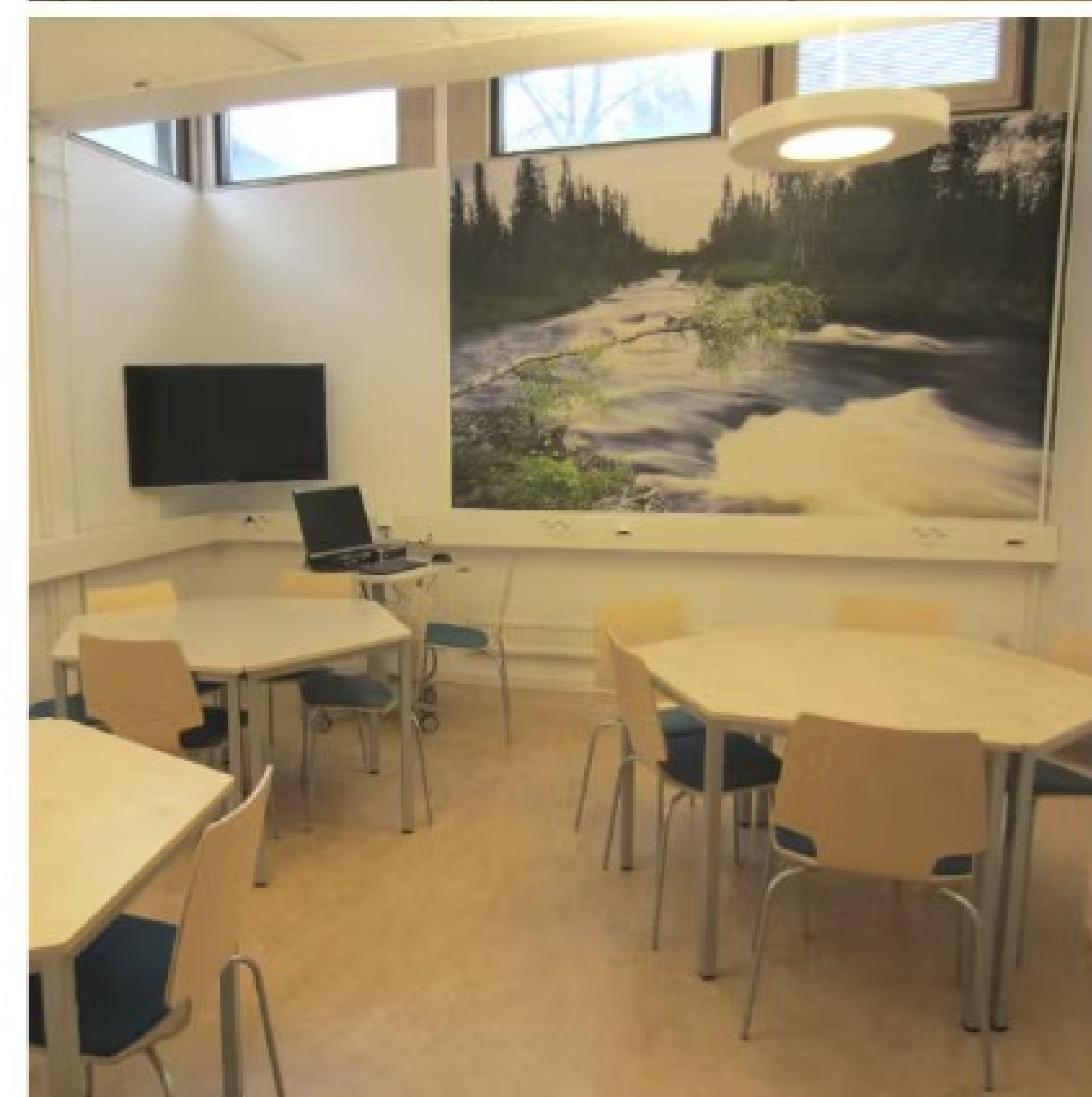


# Open with keycards all days:

- Umeå: 07.00-24.00



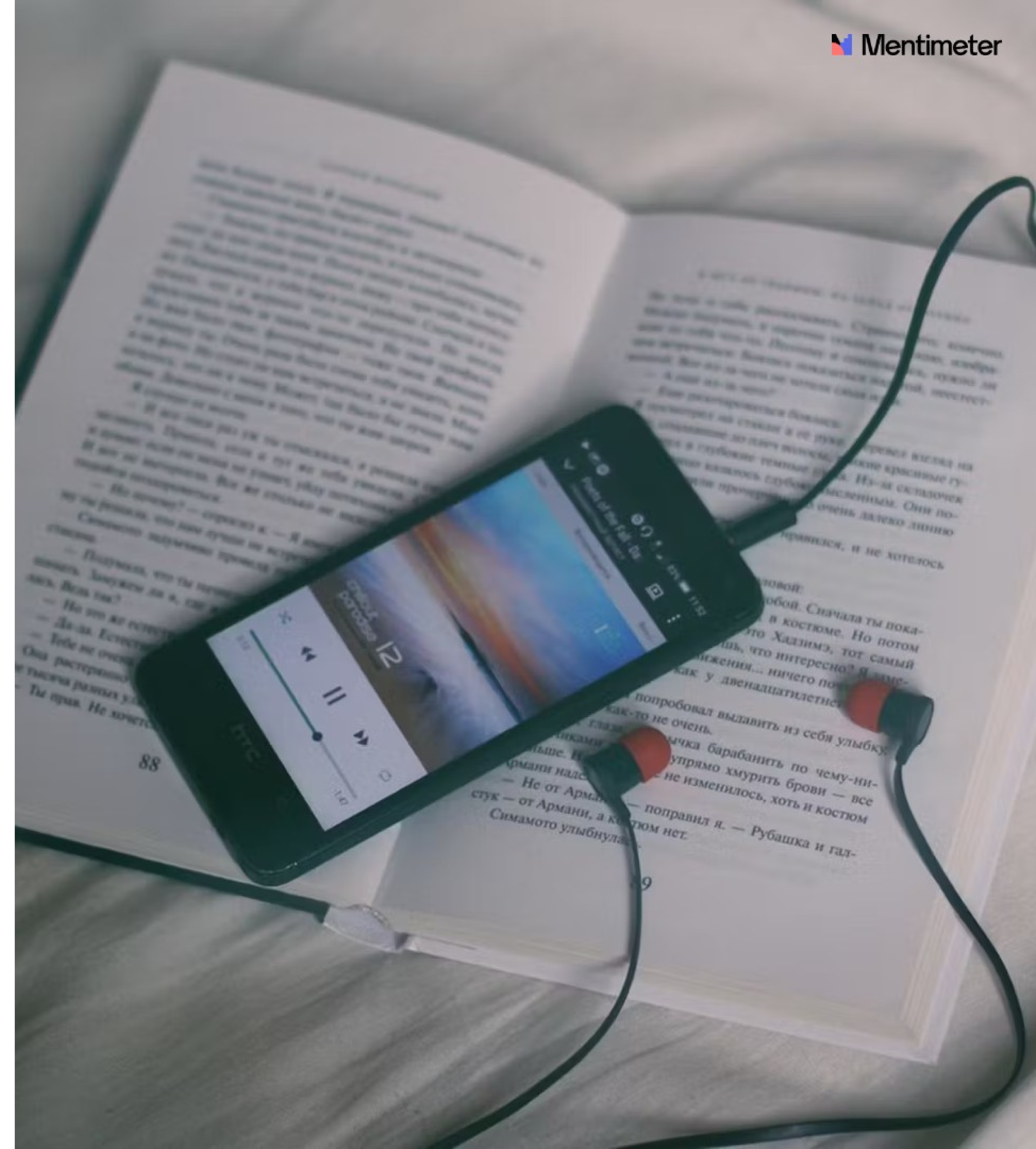
# Bookable study rooms
